- **Any photographic evidence** of damages and restorative work
- **Insurance policy or claim** details if applicable
- **A bank statement** for the account nominated to have funds paid into

Category B assistance for primary producers is designed to provide emergency assistance to ensure public safety and support primary producers to recover from a disaster event.

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Available assistance includes the following:

Fencing assistance (100% reimbursement)

This assistance reimburses 100% of the costs associated with any of the following:

- costs of restoration or replacement of fencing (to pre-disaster standard) where the fencing has been deliberately dismantled or damaged to counter the disaster; and/or
- costs of **materials only** (to pre-disaster standard) to repair or replace boundary fencing damaged or lost as a direct result of the disaster,
 - where the fencing adjoins a major road or rail transport corridor
 - and where the roaming of livestock may present a danger to the travelling public (i.e., the aim being to preserve public safety).

Advice may relate to business or financial matters, hydrological or soil conservation issues, feed analysis or other stock health concerns.

This grant is not available to meet the costs of normal business expenses or for employing professional advice for other purposes.

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Interest rate subsidy on a new loan (expression of interest)

This assistance is an interest rate subsidy on a new loan secured for recovery from the disaster. This may include repair of damage caused by the disaster, implementing measures for next season's production or replacing lost livestock or assets.

The current maximum principal loan amount which qualifies for an interest rate subsidy is \$150,000.

Please note that your expression of interest is to establish whether your business is likely to be eligible and should not be considered 'approval' for this assistance measure.

- Your expression of interest will be initially reviewed by the Department of Primary Industries and Regional Development (DPIRD).
- The Department of Fire and Emergency Services will then liaise directly with you to apply with a participating authorised deposit taking institution (ADTI); the lender.
- The ADTI will assess your eligibility against lending guidelines.
