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### Interest rate subsidy on a new loan (expression of interest)

The current maximum principal loan amount which qualifies for an interest rate subsidy is \$150,000.

Please note that your expression of interest is to establish whether your business is likely to be eligible and should not be considered 'approval' for this assistance measure.

- Your expression of interest will be initially reviewed by the Department of Primary Industries and Regional Development (DPIRD).
- The Department of Fire and Emergency Services will then liaise directly with you to apply with a participating authorised deposit taking institution (ADTI); the lender.
- The ADTI will assess your eligibility against lending guidelines.
