## AGRN 1280 Severe Tropical Cyclone Narelle and Associated Flooding - Category D

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### Purpose of Assistance

The purpose of the Category D Primary Producers Assistance is to provide grants of up to a maximum of \$40,000 to eligible primary producers to support the clean-up and reinstatement of primary production enterprises directly impacted by a declared disaster event.

This assistance is delivered under the Disaster Recovery Funding Arrangements Western Australia (DRFAWA) and is designed to support primary producers to restore operations and recover from the impacts of the disaster.

### Eligible Activities

Funding under this program supports the following eligible activities:

- Removal and disposal of debris, damaged materials and waste
- Repair or reinstatement of essential infrastructure
- Repair, replacement or reconditioning of plant and equipment
- Restoration of crops, livestock and primary production operations

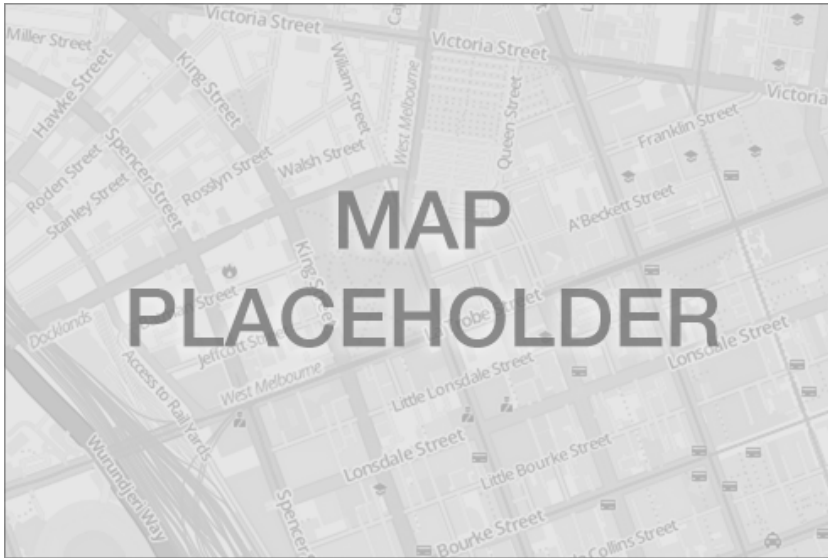
