The 2026 Bird Flu Wildlife Resilience Grant is an initiative of the WA Government, delivered by the Department of Primary Industries and Regional Development (DPIRD) in partnership with the Department of Biodiversity, Conservation and Attractions (DBCA).

The grants are available to support local community groups directly address the impact of H5 Avian Influenza (bird flu) on WA wildlife.

Grants are available to eligible licensed wildlife rehabilitators for a range of purposes, including enhancing biosecurity measures, purchasing consumables, and undertaking relevant training.

The grant is offered in 3 tiers:

- for individual applicants, up to \$1,500 (excluding GST)
- for organisations with 2-10 people, up to \$5,000 (excluding GST)
- for organisations with more than 11 people, up to \$10,000 (excluding GST).

Applications must be submitted by 12.00 noon AWST on Thursday 10 December 2026.

Applications will be processed as received and the scheme will remain open until the closing date or until all funds are allocated, whichever comes first.

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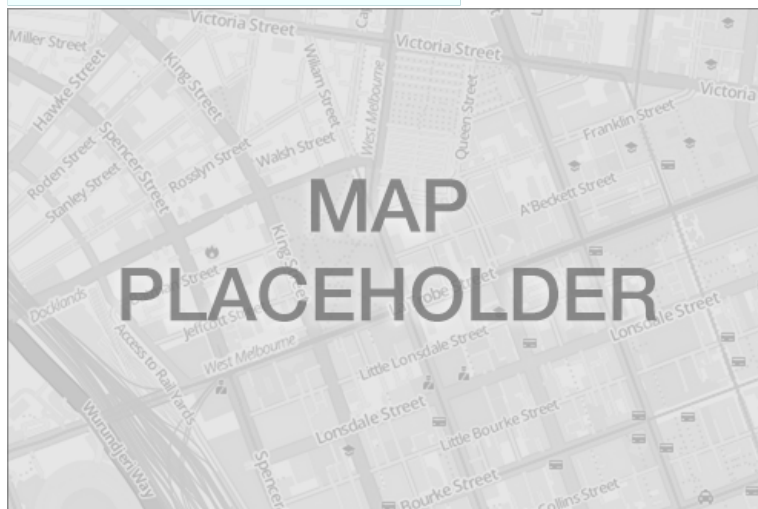
