The North Midlands Regional Drought Resilience Plan Community Grant provides funding to support community led initiatives that strengthen resilience to dry seasons and drought across the North Midlands subregion of Western Australia. For the purposes of the North Midlands Regional Drought Resilience Plan, the subregion includes the Shires of Carnamah, Coorow, Irwin, Morawa, Mingenew, Perenjori and Three Springs.

The grant program forms part of the implementation phase of the Mid West Regional Drought Resilience Plan for the North Midlands subregion and is funded through the Regional Drought Resilience Planning Program, jointly supported by the Australian Government's Future Drought Fund and the Western Australian Government.

The Community Grant supports delivery of projects aligned with the themes, outcomes and action ideas identified in the Regional Drought Resilience Plan.

The program strengthens collaboration between community organisations, local governments and regional stakeholders and supports initiatives that contribute to economic, environmental and social resilience across the subregion.
