

Funding Acknowledgement Guide

The Feral Cat Management (FCM) Grants are an initiative of the State Government, delivered by the Department of Primary Industries and Regional Development's (DPIRD) State Natural Resource Management Program in partnership with the Department of Biodiversity, Conservation and Attractions (DBCA).

When should I acknowledge the funding?

Every mention of your project should acknowledge funding from the State Government. Examples include:

- Media releases, announcements, newspaper articles, radio interviews
- Social media posts, websites
- Newsletters, brochures, flyers
- Signage, pull-up banners
- Events, workshops, forums, conferences.

The State NRM Program **must** approve all acknowledgements prior to public release.

Acknowledgement using the logo

The logo should be used on all publications, advertising, media releases and any other form of communication in relation to your project. The logo must be used in the same ratio of height to width, must not be distorted, and must be a minimum of 1.5 cm high.

Written acknowledgement

Acknowledgement text as outlined below **must** be included on all publications, advertising, media releases or any other form of communication in relation to your project.

For signage or plaques, the written acknowledgement used is:

- This [project] is supported by funding from the State Government.

For all other communication forms relating to your project, the written acknowledgement used is:

- This [project/report/forum] is supported by funding from the State Government's Feral Cat Management Grants.

Verbal acknowledgement

The following example illustrates appropriate words that can be used to acknowledge your funding source in videos, radio, speaking engagements, public launches, forums or on television:

- The [name of project] received funding as part of the State Government's Feral Cat Management Grants.
